



WORSHIP TEAM AGREEMENT

The songs we sing will affect the lives we live. Hope Youth Worship Team seeks to create environments in which people can encounter Jesus in powerful and transformative ways. This is a covenant of expectations for the youth team members, youth leaders and parents to abide to as we agree to lead people into a deeper worship experience with excellence and authenticity.

The youth will lead worship every Wednesday at Hope Youth. The expectation is that anyone who commits to the worship team will rehearse the songs and commit to practicing their instruments on their own time. The youth are also invited to lead worship on the 5th Sunday of every month in the main service. The following are the dates for leading worship in the main service: September 29, December 29, March 29, May 31, and August 30.

Mandatory group practice times will look like this:

- We will practice on the Wednesdays that the youth worship team is leading. This practice will occur from 6:00pm until 7:00pm.
- The worship leader will lead the youth in a 5 minute devotional before every practice.
- There will be an opportunity for prayer and confession before leading others into worship (*Matthew 5:22-24*).
- You will practice on Thursday evening (7-9pm) if you are joining the youth team to play the 5th Sunday of the month.
- Communication will be done by text from the youth worship leader as he sends out information about practices for the team. The youth pastor will be cc'd to these text messages.

Signing this covenant ensures that there is an understanding of the expectations for each person on the Hope Youth Worship Team. If a team member is not cooperating with the group or refuses to practice on their own time, they may be asked to step down. The goal of the worship team is to lead people to grow closer to God through songs as we serve together.
