DEVOTIONAL

Did you know that there are different ways you can follow in someone's steps? One way is to walk behind the person and follow where he is going. That's a lot like playing Follow the Leader. Another way to follow in someone's steps is to be like them, to act like them, to do what they have done, or to follow their example. The Bible tells us that we should follow in Jesus' steps and we've been talking a lot lately about following the Jesus Way of doing life. But you can't walk behind Jesus and follow in his steps because he is up in heaven with God! So how can you follow him? By being like him.

In Philippians 2, Paul says that we can be like Jesus who was humble and kind and had a servant heart. Paul says that we should continue to work hard at knowing Jesus so that people will see what good living is and how good God is. Let's think of other ways that we could show that we love Jesus. (Let your child respond). Play a game with those responses or use the ones below to remind your child of how Jesus acted and how we should act like him.

- 1. "Jesus was friendly" and shake your child's hand.
- 2. "Jesus was kind." Bend over and pretend to tie the child's shoe lace.
- 3. "Jesus was giving." Pull a penny or something out of your pocket and give it to the child.
- 4. "Jesus was happy." Smile at the child.
- 5. "Jesus studied the Bible." Open your hands to pretend to read a book.
- 6."Jesus praised God" Hold up your hands and say "Praise the Lord!"
- 7. "Jesus cared about others" Pat the child's shoulder.
- 8. "Jesus was honest" Hold up one hand like you were going to take an oath.
- 9."Jesus was encouraging" Hold up a fist and give a cheer like "You can do it." 10."Jesus prayed" - Fold your hands.
- 11. "Jesus loved everyone" Give the child a hug.
- To finish say, "Jesus shared". Give a cookie or a snack to your child.

To remind your child to act like Jesus, trace his foot on a piece of paper. Have your child cut out and colour the foot. Write on it "Follow the Jesus way" and post where your child can see it.

DEVOTIONAL LELLE

Grab a piece of $8 \frac{1}{2''} \times 8 \frac{1}{2''}$ piece of paper and a pencil. Then follow the directions given below. If you're doing this with a friend, don't look at their paper! And don't worry about doing it wrong, just do your best!


- 1. Draw a line all the way across your paper to divide it in half vertically and draw another line all the way across your paper to divide it in half horizontally.
- 2. In the top left square draw 3 lines evenly spaced from the top of the square to the bottom.
- 3. In the top right square draw a 1/2-inch circle in each corner. Draw two more circles the same size evenly spaced between each of the 4 circles you just drew around the edge of the square.
- 4. In the bottom left square draw a diagonal line from the top left corner to the bottom right corner and a diagonal line from the right top corner to the bottom left corner.
- 5.Draw a two-inch wide circle in the center of the same square.
- 6.Draw a one-inch wide circle in the center of the bottom right square of your paper.
- 7. Draw a straight line from the bottom edge of the circle to the bottom edge of the paper.
- 8. Draw circles about half the size you just drew evenly spaced all the way around the outside of the circle you just drew so that they are all touching but not overlapping.

Ok, how did that go? Do you have some pretty funky looking drawings on your page? You can look to the next page to see what your sheet should like look. Now draw a second picture, following the instructions a second time now that you know how to follow the instructions properly.


What does it mean to follow in someone's steps? It means to copy what another person is doing, or to do what they have done or are doing. For example, if a child has a father who is a doctor and decides that she wants to be a doctor too, she is following in her father's steps. Can you think of ways you are following in your parent's footsteps? How are you like your parents? We follow in our parents' footsteps in some ways, and that is good if our parents are good examples, but our parents aren't perfect.

In Philippians 2, Paul talks about how we should be like Jesus. We've been talking for the last 11 weeks about following the Jesus Way of doing life. And in this passage, Paul tells us that Jesus should be our example. Did you ever call someone a bad name because he called you a bad name? Did you ever get mad at someone for doing something mean to you and then told him that he would be sorry because you would get even? If you have, that is not following the Jesus Way. None of us are perfect. None of us completely understand God's words. But the more you study the Bible and learn to follow Jesus' steps, the closer you will be to becoming like Jesus. You will make a lot of mistakes along the way. You may lose his tracks and go in the wrong direction sometimes, but God is patient and will guide you and turn you around if you get sidetracked. He has also given you parents and teachers to help you find his steps. But, most importantly, he gives you the Holy Spirit to guide and direct you and help you to do the right thing.

Let's look at the first picture you drew again. With the first picture you drew you only had the instructions and it doesn't quite look like this picture, does it? Now look at your second drawing. It probably looks a lot like this one below, right? That's because you could see the picture you were drawing. It is the same way with Jesus. When we follow what he tells us in the Bible, we are going to more closely resemble Jesus and follow in his way.



Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."








