FAMILY DEVOTIONAL



Here are some quick questions for you:

1. When you have something really, really important to tell your best friend, do you:
 - a. Send a carrier pigeon out with a note in its beak? Do you even have a pigeon?
 - b. Drive over to your best friend's house? Hey wait a minute – can you drive yet?
 - c. Print a special invitation asking your friend to come to your house?
 - d. Tell them face to face?
2. When you have something really, really important to say to God, do you:
 - a. Write it on a paper airplane and launch it up towards the sky?
 - b. Think to yourself, "God knows everything anyway so I don't need to tell Him."
 - c. Forget it because you think God doesn't bother listening to kids?
 - d. Stop and pray wherever you are, telling God about the situation?

Prayer is communicating or talking with God just like you would with your best friend. We may not be able to call God on the telephone or send Him a letter or see him on FaceTime like we can with our friends and family, but prayer is just as real as e-mail or text messages. And we can pray about anything – that upsetting situation with a friend, the upcoming math test at school, the health of our families, the decision to join the volleyball team. God wants us to talk to Him and to get His direction for our lives. God is good and will help us when we are happy, sad, sick or even when we're in trouble. God will give us wisdom, strength and understanding if we only ask Him.

And we should also pray for other people, not just our own needs. If we only pray for ourselves, we might start to think the world revolves around us and that only our needs are important. Spoiler alert: That's not true! God put us in relationship with other people so we could love and bless them. And one important way to do that is to pray for them.

Not convinced? Try praying for your little brother the next time he bursts into your room unannounced or for your sister when she wears your favourite t-shirt. Turn your anger or resentment into a prayer for their well-being, protection, and growth. That kind of prayer is powerful!

Here are some great ways to pray for others that will be a blessing to them, even if they don't know that you are praying!

1. Every time you thank God for your food, add a prayer of blessing for someone older than you – your parents, teacher, sibling, grandparents, coach.
2. Find a map and pick a country to pray for, maybe one that doesn't have a lot of Christians in it. Every night at bedtime, ask Jesus to make Himself known to the people of that land.
3. Any time you are waiting, maybe in line at school or for the microwave at home, say, "Jesus please bless..." and start naming people alphabetically. See how far you get until your wait is over!
4. Every day at bedtime pray a blessing for the 3 Ps: Prime Minister, parents, pastors.
