# The Palm Palm!

Get it? Palm Palm! It's funny 'cause you wave it!

#### You will need...

- green paper (or you can colour some plain paper)
- tape (I used clear scotch tape)
- something sturdy for the step (I used a pencil)
- something to draw with
- a pair of scissors
- hands

### Step 1: Trace



Trace around your hand on a piece of paper. I used pencil so that I wouldn't get colour all over my hands. Fill up the paper with as many hands as you can!

#### Step 2: Cut



Cut out your hand shapes - it doesn't need to be perfect, just the general shape of your palm and fingers.

## Step 3: Repeat



Make a whole bunch of these hand shapes! You can change up the colour of green you are using if you like!

### Step 4: Tape



Attach one hand to the top of the stem using tape. Make sure to tape all the way to the top of the stem so that it will stay in place.

### Step 5: Repeat



Start adding more hands! With the stem side facing you, add additional hands behind the ones already attached. Place each new hand off-set so that they overlap working down the stem.



With each new hand, there will be more places you can tape the hands together on the stem side. Tape them together wherever you can on the stem side.



When you've filled up the whole stem (leaving enough to hold onto), you can start adding more hands to the top from the stem side to make it taller!
