# FAMILY DEVOTIONAL



Mark 7:31-36

Think of a soccer ball, a paintbrush and a music book. Now ask yourself – Do you know someone who is such an amazing soccer player that teams from Europe are calling for them? Do you know someone who creates such beautiful scenes on a canvas that their paintings are hung in exclusive galleries in big cities? Do you know someone who plays the piano so well that they can hold sell-out concerts in huge music halls?

All of us have some things that we can do very well but none of us can do everything well, can we? Only one person does everything well. You know Who that is – Jesus!

Our Bible story today is from Mark 7:31-36 – look it up! One day some people brought a man to Jesus who could not hear and could hardly talk. The people begged Jesus to heal their friend. The Bible tells us that Jesus put his fingers in the man's ears and touched his tongue. Then Jesus called out, "Be opened!". As soon as Jesus spoke these words, the man's ears were opened and he could hear and his tongue was healed and he could speak! Wow! The people were amazed and said, "He has done everything well!"

Jesus has done many great things for you and me. And we should do good things for each other to follow the example of Jesus. Some of the things we do for others are easy to do! For example, if you like to bake, it's easy for you to give cookies to your neighbour when they are sick. If you like to draw, you probably enjoy making a card for someone who is sad.

But other things are much harder. Say your friend needs you to help you move a big piece of furniture but you're not that strong. Maybe they need you to help them write a letter but you aren't great at spelling. Maybe they really need you to pray for them before a big exam but you don't like to pray out loud. Sometimes, the way people need to be helped is NOT the way we like to help. It's uncomfortable and not what we do well.

It's important to remember the times we have been helped, when our friends did the best they could and in doing so, they showed us God's love, even if their help wasn't perfect! Just having someone attempt to help us is a sign of how much we mean to others. And that makes a huge difference in our lives! It's wonderful to help people in the ways we are good at but it's also important to remember that we might need to do other things that we aren't so good at, to show love and kindness to our friends! Jesus is the only one who can do everything well!
