Wise Builders

Look at the list of actions and circle the ones you think are wise choices:

- Praying for a sick friend • Playing loud music that disturbs your neighbours •
 - Calling someone bad names • Hitting your sister in the face •
- Reading your Bible • Saying thank you for a birthday gift •
 - Stealing money from your mom's purse • Helping your dad with chores •

Today's Bible story has to do with making a wise choice. It's a parable or a story with an important spiritual truth told by Jesus to the people who were following Him. Some of these people were listening to what He was teaching and then doing what He said. But others, even though they were listening, were not putting into practice the things Jesus was teaching. Grab a Bible and read Luke 6:46-49.

Isn't that an interesting story! Have you ever seen a house being built? A large hole is usually dug and a strong foundation is usually poured, right? Have you ever seen a house built on a sand pile? I haven't either! Would you want to live in a house like that? No way! Here in Saskatchewan, we have a lot of wind and even some crazy storms so any house that is built on something shaky like a pile of sand would be unstable and even dangerous.

What was Jesus trying to tell us through this parable about these two people who built houses? He was making the point that people who read God's Word but don't do what it says (like be kind and loving, forgive your enemies, trust God, etc.) are like people who spend the time and money to build a house on a sand pile. One difficulty or hardship and BAM! Their whole life falls apart.

It's important for us to be like the person who built his house on the rock. Jesus said that person doesn't have to fear that his house is going to blow away or be swamped with water when a storm hits. That house is going to stand strong, just like the life of a person who builds on the foundation of what God says! Wise people build their lives on what Jesus says. Let's choose to be wise!

What happened to the foolish man when the storm came?

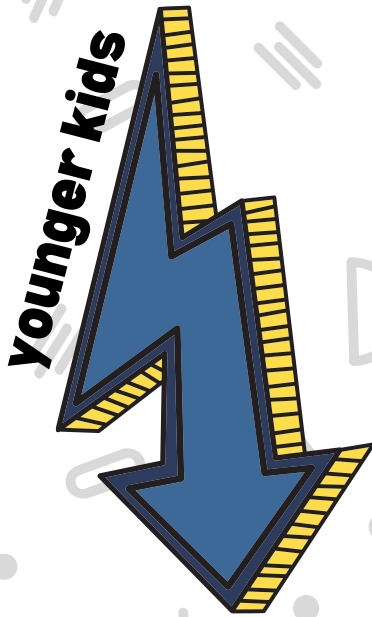
